- Performers may prepare one piece of their choice, or a set of shorter pieces by the same composer.
- The event runs ALL day. Please, make your day available. Students may request morning or afternoon playing time.
- The Festival is run in recitals form. The performances are adjudicated by judges and the judges' comments are sent to students' teachers approximately one week after the event.
- In addition to comments all students receive medals of participation.
